

Vallepicciola represents Chianti Classico at the most important wine events in Italy and around the world.

Vinitaly, Gambero Rosso International, Wine People, Great Wines of the World, God Save The Wine, BuyWine and Vini d'Abbazia, these are the big spring events to get to know the Vallepicciola winery, originally from Val di Picciola in Chianti Classico in Tuscany. In addition, this year the range of winery experiences is enhanced with the new "6 Shades of White," a proposal that combines a relaxing walk through the vineyards with a guided tour of the winery and tasting of six white wines. The precious bubbles of Petit Vallée (Vallepicciola) signature champagnes, the savoriness of still wines, ending with the tradition of Vin Santo, all accompanied by a very careful selection of local cheeses.

Castelnuovo Berardenga (SI), March 14, 2024 - Vallepicciola's spring is marked by a rich calendar of events between Italy and the rest of the world. A sensory journey to discover new flavors, scents and shades of colors awaits wine lovers. From Rome to Verona, passing through Florence, the United States and Latina. A series of great opportunities to taste the labels of Vallepicciola, owned by the Bolfo Family, a winery of excellence among the most representative of Tuscany, located only 12 km from the historic city of Siena. In addition, to experience firsthand the warm Tuscan hospitality, at the winery you can pamper yourself with 6 Shades of White, the enogastronomic itinerary designed specifically for lovers of white wines and bubbles where each glass is paired impeccably with a high-quality dairy product.

NATIONAL EVENTS

The season begins with God Save The Wine in Rome on March 23, an opportunity to try wines such as Chianti Classico 2021, Pievasciata Rosso 2020 and Perlinetto Rosé metodo classico. On April 10 and 11 it is the turn of BuyWine Toscana in Florence, the largest wine trade initiative in the region, where it will be possible to exchange opinions and ideas about Vallepicciola's award-winning wines with winemaker Alessandro Cellai. A few days later, from April 14 to 17, the appointment with the 56th edition of Vinitaly - the international wine and spirits fair - in the romantic city of Verona is unmissable; at Hall 9, stand D16 the winery will be present with its labels, including the prized line of Grand Cru: three wines that represent the highest expression of a valley rich in history and passion for wine - Vallepicciola Bianco (100%) Chardonnay), Vallepicciola Rosso (100% Sangiovese), Migliorè (Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot). On May 8, at Wine People, the winery returns to Florence along with its Boscobruno 2022 (100% Pinot Noir), while on May 23 at the florentine edition of GSTW it confirms its Chianti, Pievasciata rosso and Perlinetto rosé. From 7 to 9 of June Vallepicciola will participate in Vini d'Abbazia in the historic village of Fossanova, Priverno in the province of Latina. Immersed in the ancient atmosphere of the 12th-century Cistercian abbey, guests will enjoy a timeless journey among tasting counters, wine and Slow Food products. Finally, an exciting experience at Vallepicciola is the 6 Shades of White: a walk through the magnificent vineyards of the Val di Picciola with a guided tour of the fermentation room, the ageing rooms and the sparkling wine area; the tour then continues with a tasting of six iconic whites: starting with the Pievasciata line, passing through the Vallepicciola Bianco from the Grand Cru line to the special Champagne Petit Vallée, in its very elegant Blanc de Noirs and Blanc de Blancs versions.

INTERNATIONAL MEETINGS AND TASTINGS

From Italy we fly to America, specifically to Dallas, Texas, to the Gambero Rosso International event scheduled for April 29 for an exclusive tasting of Italian wines including Chianti Classico 2021, Chianti Classico Riserva 2019, Vallepicciola Rosso 2021 and Migliorè 2020. On June 5, the winery lands in the Big Apple at James Suckling's Great Wines of the World - a gathering highlighting wines carefully selected from more than 300 producers from around the world. Curated by the great international critic, the event grants the chance to explore a variety of wines on a global scale, right in the heart of New York City.

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
